

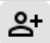
DIGITAL TEEN PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST

BPL'S 28TH ANNUAL TEEN PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST IS NOW ONLINE!

All students in grades 9-12 living within the Baldwinsville School District are eligible to enter! There is a limit of 2 photographs per person. Please fill out the *Photographer's Information Form*. You must also fill out a *Photograph Consent Form* for each recognizable person in each photograph submission.

To submit your photograph create a folder in your Google Drive. You can submit a .jpg, .png, .tiff or .raw file. Title your folder:
studentname_school_grade.

For example: **daniasoud_baker_11**

Add your photograph, Photographer's Information Form, and Photograph Consent Form into the folder. Once you're ready to submit, click on **share with others** ( con in the top right corner). Make sure **anyone with the link can view** is selected. To do so, click on **more** in the drop down menu and select **anyone with the link can view** from the options.

Copy the link. Submit the link through the **Photography Submission Form**. A link to the this form is in the original email you received about this contest.

If you **do not attend a school in the B'ville School District**, you can email your photographs, and completed forms to BPL's Young Adult Services Librarian, Dania Souid, at **danias@bville.lib.ny.us**. This submission process is **only** for home school students or students living in B'ville but attending a different school.

The submission deadline is **Monday , June 8, 2020**. The photographs will be judged by a panel of professionals. Criteria for judging include: technical ability, creativity, and impact of the photo. All accepted photos will be on display on the B'ville Library website and our other digital platforms.

First prize is \$100. Second prize is \$50. Third prize is \$25. Darkroom prize is \$25. Two judges' choice awards.



28th Annual BPL Digital Teen Photography Contest

Rules:

- The contest is open to all students in grades 9-12 living in the Baldwinsville School district.
- Students can submit a maximum of 2 entries.
- The deadline to submit photographs is **Monday, June 8, 2020**.

To Submit:

- Create a folder in your Google Drive. Title the folder: **studentname_school_grade**
For example: **daniasouid_baker_11**
- Submit photos as a .jpg, .png, .tiff, .raw file.
- Submit a *Photographer's Information Form* (below) for each photograph submitted.
- Submit a *Photographic Consent Form* (below) for each recognizable person in each photograph.
- Put your photograph, *Photographer's Information Form*, and *Photo Consent Form* in your Google Drive folder.
- Make sure the folder is shareable so **anyone with the link can view**.
- Click on the + icon in the top right of your Google Drive.
- If **anyone with the link can view** is not selected, click on **more** in the dropdown menu and select it from the list.
- Copy a link to your Google Drive folder.
- Paste the link in the *Photography Submission Form*. You will have received a link to this form in the email about this contest.
- If you have any questions, please email Dania Souid at danias@bville.lib.ny.us. She is the Teen Librarian at B'ville Library and is coordinating the contest with the photography teachers in the school district.

Other Submission Option:

- This submission option is **only** for home school students or students living in Baldwinsville but attending a different school.
