

29th ANNUAL BALDWINSVILLE PUBLIC LIBRARY PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST

September 2020 through April 16, 2021 at 5 PM

Do you like to take photographs? Make your best shot count when you enter the 29th Annual Baldwinsville Public Library Photography Contest sponsored by the Baldwinsville Center for the Arts.

All students in grades 9 - 12 living in the Baldwinsville School District are eligible to participate. Photographs of any size must be unframed and **mounted on white or black 11 x 14 inch mount board**. An **11 x 14 inch** white or black mat (overlaid) may also be used if desired. There is a limit of two entries per person and they must be original and taken within the last year. We require a *Photographic Consent Form* for each recognizable person in each photograph entered in the contest.

Registration forms with the rules will be available at the Baldwinsville Public Library and website, as well as the junior and high school libraries and photography classrooms.

Submit contest entries to the Baldwinsville Public Library the week of **April 12, 2021** with a deadline of **5 PM on April 16, 2021**. Judging will follow and winning entries accepted for exhibition will be awarded a ribbon. Criteria for judging will include technical abilities, creativity and impact of the photo. All accepted photos will be on display in the Baldwinsville Public Library Art Gallery during May 2021.

First prize of \$100, Second Prize of \$100, Third Prize of \$50, a Darkroom Prize of \$50, three Judges Choice Awards and a People's Choice Award (voted on by library patrons in May).

In early May, there will be a reception at the Baldwinsville Public Library in honor of the students participating in the contest, during which the awards will be presented.

RULES:

The contest is open to all students living in the Baldwinsville School District in Grades 9-12.

Entries, no more than two per student, must be received at the Baldwinsville Public Library no later than **5 PM on Friday, April 16, 2021.**

Entries must be original photographs taken by the student within the last 12 months.

Photographs of any size, black & white or color must be unframed and mounted on white **or black 11 x 14 inch** mount board. An **11 x 14 inch white or black mat** (overlaid) may also be used if desired. All photographs must be titled. A *Photographic Consent Form* for each recognizable person in each photograph must accompany the photographs entered in the contest. These forms should be taped to the back of the related photograph.

The title, photographer's name, grade, address and phone number must appear on the back of the mount board and **placed appropriately showing which side is up for the photo.** No names or titles are to be written on the front of the photograph. Entries will be judged on creativity, impact and technical abilities. All accepted photographs will be on display in the Baldwinsville Public Library during May 2021. Baldwinsville Public Library assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to any entry. All photographs not claimed by Monday, August 2, 2021 will become the property of the Baldwinsville Public Library.

OTHER INFORMATION

No entry fee is required. At the art reception in May 2021, the following cash prizes will be awarded: 1st \$200.00, 2nd \$100.00, and 3rd \$50.00, a Darkroom Prize \$50.00. In addition, each judge will award a "Judge's Choice" award to their favorite photograph. All photographs accepted will be displayed during the month of May. The People's Choice Award will be voted on by the library patrons during the month of May and winning photo will be exhibited in June in the library. Participants will be notified by mail OR email when the judging is complete.
