Get Help with Tech-Talk

Getting frustrated with your new phone? Working on a spreadsheet and you can't sort your data? Need help setting up your LinkedIn profile? Baldwinsville Public Library staff are always happy to help if you're in the building, but what if you're home or at work? That's when you go to Tech-Talk.

Provided to patrons by BPL, Tech-Talk is an online collection of videos and articles written by training experts on an array of technical and communication topics. Examples include:

- What Do You Do With Old Electronics?
- Organize Your Desktop & Email
- Show You Listen, Give Feedback

How do you get started? Go to the library website (www.bville.lib.ny.us) and scroll down our main page for the link to Tech-Talk. The username and password are provided with this link. Once logged into Tech-Talk's site, click on the **New?** tab at the top of the page and follow the six steps to get started.

Do you want to jump right in and start using Tech-Talk? Go to the Search tab at the top of any page and search either by keyword or by selecting a topic from a pull-down menu. We recommend that you take moment to look at all the topics listed in that menu and click on a few that interest you. This will give you a good idea of how vast the information contained on this site is and we're sure you will find many topics you'll want to explore further. The training is designed to accommodate different learning styles, so you will find articles, video tutorials, and webinars.

If you have any questions or want some one-on-one training, call us at 315-635-5631 to make an appointment with one of our librarians. We think you'll find Tech-Talk a great way to enhance your technical and communication skills.

We are currently gathering on Discord, using chat (typing and posting pictures) and voice channels to play D&D 5e. **Register for this event to get a link to the Discord channel.**

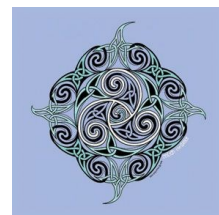

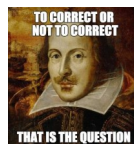
