WHAT TO KNOW!

- Summer reading is for all ages at BPL! We have pre-k, children, teen, and adult programs. You can log reading and much more on [READSQUARED](#) or on one of our paper logs! Read through this newsletter for more information.
- We're also very excited to work with Tom and Maureen Annal to create a fresh and inviting new children's area, while honoring the memory of their angels Maryella and Elizabeth Annal. Most of the children's collection has been moved to the community room, with some material in other library spaces.
- Due to the construction, many of our programs will be held outside in our back parking lot with cones cornering off the space. Each program highlighted in this newsletter includes the space it will be held.

SIGN UP FOR SUMMER READING

PRE-K (0-5) & CHILDREN (K-6)

1. Log at least once a week on READSquared or on your paper log. Being **READ TO** counts!
2. Stop by the children's desk once a week to ask for your craft kit prize!
3. These prizes are based on the honor system! We won't be keeping track of who picks up a craft kit or if they had logged that week.
4. Please only take one prize a week so we can have enough for everyone!
5. At the end of the summer, every one in both the pre-k and children's program will receive a **COMPLETION CERTIFICATE** and **FREE BOOK** to take home!
6. Everyone in the **CHILDREN'S PROGRAM** will be entered in a raffle to win a grand prize!

TEENS (13-18):

1. Log at least once a week on READSquared or on your paper log.
2. The Young Adult Services Librarian will keep track how much everyone logs.
3. Every Monday, come to the library to pick up your craft kit from the holds shelf, it will be labeled with your name.
4. At the end of the summer, all the participating teens will receive a final prize.
5. All the teens that participated will also be entered in a raffle to win a grand prize!
 - a. The librarian will keep track of tickets earned and put the right amount of tickets for each participant in the raffle. The more tickets-the higher your chances of winning a grand prize!

ADULTS (18+):

1. Log at least once a week on READSquared or on your paper log.
2. The Adult Services Librarian will keep track of everyone who logs.
3. Every week there will be a drawing for prizes for anyone that has logged reading.
4. The more you read, the more raffle tickets you will earn for the weekly prize.
5. If you reach 1000 points, you are entered to win grand prizes at the end of the summer.

USING READSQUARED!

SIGN UP:

1. Go to **bvillenyo5.readsquared.com** OR download and open the free READSquared app for iOS or Android.
2. If you've participated in our summer reading program before, you can log in with your previous user name and password.
3. Don't have an account? Click the green **REGISTER NOW** and answer a few questions to create an account.

LOGGING:

1. From your home screen on READSquared, select **LOGGING** from the left side menu.
2. Under **LOG ACTIVITY** select **LOG**.
3. Select either books, pages, audiobooks, ebooks, or picture books (this list may look different depending on which program you're enrolled in.)
4. Fill out the empty blocks with book title, author, pages read, minutes read, etc.
5. Hit **Submit!**
6. You will earn a certain amount of points and earn badges, raffle tickets, etc. depending on your program!

Log at least once a week in the pre-k, children, or teen programs to earn a weekly craft kit! Adults have chances every week to win a prize.

COMPLETE MISSIONS:

1. Exclusive to the **TEEN AND ADULT SUMMER READING PROGRAMS**.
2. From your home screen, select **MISSIONS** from the left side menu.
3. Click on the mission you want to complete.
4. Do what the mission requires!
5. Once you've completed the mission, hit **COMPLETE NOW**.
6. Fulfill the complete mission requirements, like uploading a photo, entering text, or checking a box.
7. Select **COMPLETE ACTIVITY**.
8. Earn a badge and an extra raffle ticket!
