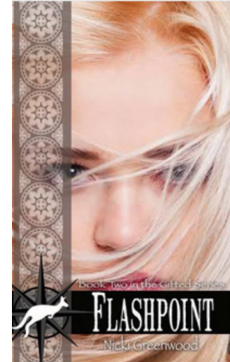
MEET THE AUTHOR

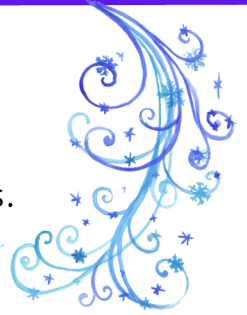
