SERVICES

As a means of achieving the purposes stated in Section I, these services are provided:

- 1. Employment of a professional librarian as director to oversee the operation of the library for the benefit of the patrons.
- 2. Provision of professional librarians to assist patrons in locating the information and materials they require.
- 3. Assistance to schools and organizations in locating and using materials.
- 4. Incorporation of appropriate and up-to-date technology to meet the educational and recreational needs of the patrons.
- 5. Provision of current, high-demand, high-interest educational and recreational materials in a variety of formats for people of all ages.
- 6. Access to collections and services at libraries within the Onondaga County Public Library (OCPL) system.
- 7. Utilization of the OCPL interlibrary loan service to provide patrons with materials from national and international sources.
- 8. Collection and preservation of materials relative to the history of Baldwinsville, Clay, Lysander, and Van Buren.
- 9. Provision of service for people with disabilities including special collections and equipment and outreach programs.
- 10. Provision of a variety of programs for people of all ages to support cultural, recreational, and intellectual interests.
- 11. Provision of meeting room space to groups whose purposes contribute to the civic, educational, and cultural advancement of the community or to the self-development of group members.
- 12. Provision of adequate hours during which the library is open.
