
Baldwinsville Public Library Impact Report 2018



The Board of Trustees has three established goals, based on input from a community forum. The following are examples of how the goals are put into action.

Goal 1: The Baldwinsville Public Library will provide community residents of all ages with a Library Staff, skilled and updated regularly in current technology:

- * Ongoing staff training to help patrons at Tech Help Drop In, Wired Wednesday and one-on-one sessions
- * Programs involving STEM activities including Cubelets and LEGOs

Goal 2: The Baldwinsville Public Library will build a partnership with Baldwinsville School District Personnel:

- * The librarians have made visits to the Baldwinsville schools and signed children up for library cards.
- * Our Art Gallery features Baldwinsville students' work from Kindergarten to Grade 12.

Goal 3: The Baldwinsville Public Library will be seen as an integral part of the Baldwinsville Community:

- * Hosts the community tree lighting after party, complete with Santa
- * Provides Empire NYS Park and Onondaga County Park passes for loan
- * Shows newly released films the week they are released
- * Loans Garden Kits for Kids provided by Baldwinsville Women's Garden Club
- * Hosts Dungeons and Dragons 5e meetings
- * Collaborates with community groups such as Rotary Club of Baldwinsville, Museum at Shacksboro Schoolhouse, Bville Center for the Arts and the Chamber of Commerce
