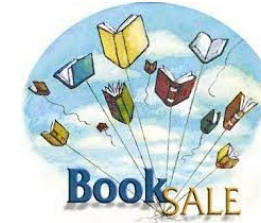

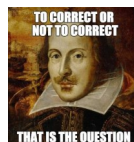

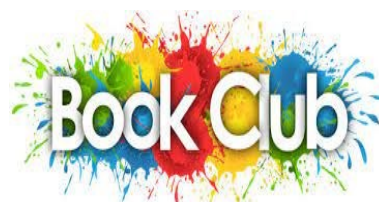


Wordsmiths Writing Group Meeting (on Zoom)
