Items that Bruin Recycling will \underline{NOT} accept

Flat-screen monitors over 24"
Televisions (neither flat-screen nor CRT)
Lawnmowers or anything with a gasoline or diesel engine or oil-burning heaters

Anything that contains coils or coolant, such as refrigerators, air conditioners, wine chillers or dehumidifiers

How to tell a television from a monitor: Look at the back of the unit, and see if there are coaxial or RCA connectors. If you see either of those types of connectors, then you have a television, not a monitor.
