### SUMMER READING IS FOR ALL AGES AT BPL!

- We have pre-k, children, teen, and adult programs.
- You can log reading, complete missions, and do so much more online or on a paper log.
- Pick up craft kits, prizes, and raffle tickets every week.
- We have fun programming for all ages every day this summer!

### SIGN UP FOR SUMMER READING

### PRE-K (0-5)& CHILDREN (K-6)

- 1. Log in at least once a week and keep track on **READSquared** or by using a **paper log**.
- 2. Each week, come to the library and pick up a craft kit.
- 3. Read for 7 days to receive a raffle ticket and a new ticket every seven days.
- 4. Read for 24 days and receive a midsummer prize.
- 5. Read every day of the summer, 48 days, and earn 3 extra raffle tickets for 10 entries.
- 6. At the beginning of the summer all the participants will receive a free book.
- 7. The Children's Librarian will keep track of tickets earned and enter tickets for each participant in the raffles for grand prizes.
  - a. The more tickets-the higher your chances of winning a grand prize.

### **TEENS (13-18):**

- 1. Log at least once a week on **READSquared** or on a **paper log**.
- 2. At the beginning of the summer all the participants will receive a free book.
- 3. The Young Adult Services Librarian will keep track of how much everyone logs and how many raffle tickets are earned.
- 4. Come to the library every week to pick up a craft kit from the holds shelf.
- 5. At the end of the summer all the participating teens will receive a final prize.
- 6. All the teens that participated will also be entered in a raffle to win a grand prize!
  - a. The more tickets-the higher your chances of winning a grand prize!

### **ADULTS (18+):**

- 1. Log at least once a week on **READSquared** or on a **paper log**.
- 2. The Adult Services Librarian will keep track of how much everyone logs.
- 3. Every week there will be a drawing for prizes for those who have logged reading.
- 4. For each 100 points (one book) you get a raffle ticket. The more you read, the more raffle tickets you will earn for the weekly prize.
- 5. If you reach 1000 points, you are entered for a chance to win one of three grand prizes!

### USING READSQUARED

### SIGN UP:

- 1. Go to **bvilleny05.readsquared.com** OR download and open the free **READsquared** app for iOS or Android.
- 2. If you've participated in our summer reading program before, you can log in with your previous user name and password.
- 3. Don't have an account? Click the green **REGISTER NOW** and answer a few questions to create an account. You will need an email address to make an account.

### LOGGING:

- 1. From your home screen on READSquared, select LOGGING from the left side menu.
- 2. Under LOG ACTIVITY select LOG.
- 3. Select either books, pages, audiobooks, ebooks, or picture books (this list may look different depending on which program you're enrolled in).
- 4. Fill the empty blocks with book title, author, pages read, minutes read, etc.
- 5. Hit Submit!
- 6. You will earn a certain amount of points and earn badges, raffle tickets, etc. depending on your program!

Log at least once a week in the pre-k, children, or teen programs to earn a weekly craft kit! Adults have chances every week to win a prize.
